Present were Reynolds GWOT Combat Veteran Marines Chris Telofski, Scott Nokes, and Jimmy Krauss.

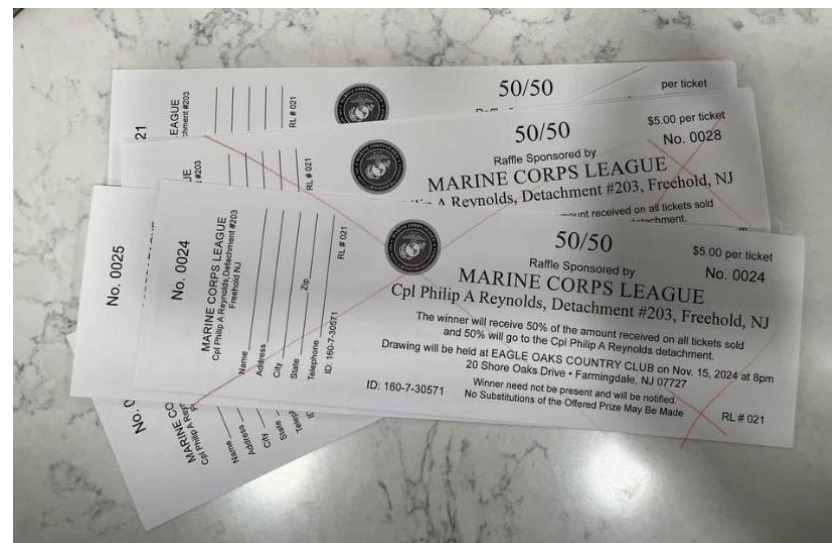
The Marines were also provided 40+ Pizzas from our partner Michael Boil from NJ Veterans Network.
